

Christ must reign until the last enemy, death, is destroyed, "so that God may be all in all." <u>GOSPEL READING: Matthew 25:31-46</u> As a shepherd separates sheep from goats, so will the Son of Man come in glory to separate those who fed the hungry from those who did not: "Whatever you did for one of the least…you did for me." When Jesus identified Himself as the Good Shepherd, His disciples probably recalled the passage from Ezekiel that we hear today.
