## **THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER - YEAR A**

#### INTRODUCTION TO THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

## **FIRST READING:** Acts 2:14, 22–33

Peter proclaimed that Jesus came with miracles, wonders, and signs so that people could know of God's love.

#### **SECOND READING:** 1 Peter 1:17-21

The blood of Christ, as of the sinless, unblemished lamb, delivered believers.

#### **GOSPEL READING:** Luke 24:13-35

Two disciples bound for Emmaus were joined by Jesus, whom they did not recognize. They discussed the death of Jesus and the disappearance of His body from the tomb. Jesus explained to them through the Scriptures the meaning of the events that had taken place. They recognized Him in the breaking of the bread.

The purpose of the Mass is to help us hear Jesus, see Jesus, receive Jesus, and serve Jesus. This description isn't exhaustive, but we can use it to reflect on today's Gospel Reading. Today's reading encourages us to truly walk the path of discipleship. In the first reading, Peter boldly proclaimed the Good News. The second reading explains that Jesus Christ died so we could have new life. And in the Gospel, two disciples encountered the risen Jesus on the road to Emmaus. Jesus revealed Himself to the disciples in the breaking of the bread. This theme emphasizes the importance of the Eucharist, and that Jesus is truly present in the bread and wine of the Eucharistic celebration.


