Sts. Joachim and Ann Parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary Sts. Joachim and Ann, both of the tribe of Judah of the royal house of David are venerated by the Church as the parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary who was probably their only child The couple's faith and perseverance brought them through the sorrow of childlessness, to the joy of conceiving and raising the immaculate and sinless woman who would give birth to Christ. The New Testament contains no specific information about the lives of the Virgin Mary's parents, but other documents outside of the Biblical canon do provide some details. Although these writings are not considered authoritative in the same manner as the Bible, they outline some of the Church's traditional beliefs about Joachim, Ann and their daughter. Joachim and Ann began to devote themselves to rigorous prayer and fasting, in isolation from one another and from society. They regarded their inability to conceive a child as a surpassing misfortune, and a sign of shame among the tribes of Israel. As it turned out, however, the	ST. couple were to be blessed even more abundantly than Abraham and Sarah. An angel revealed this to Ann when he appeared to her and prophesied that all generations would honor their future child: "The Lord has heard your prayer, and you shall conceive, and shall bring forth; and your seed shall be spoken of in all the world." After the birth of Mary, St. Ann made a sanctuary in the infant girl's room, and allowed nothing common or unclean on account of the special holiness of the child. When she was one year old, her father made a great feast, and invited the priests, and the scribes, and the elders, and all the people of Israel. St. Joachim brought the girl child to the priests and they blessed her, saying: 'O God of our fathers, bless this child, and give her an everlasting name to be named in all generations. He also brought her to the chief priests; and they blessed her, saying: 'O God most high, look upon this child, and bless her with the utmost blessing, which shall be forever.
