FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT - YEAR B

INTRODUCTION TO THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

FIRST READING: Isaiah 63:16b-17, 19b; 64:2-7

Isaiah prophesied, "all our good deeds are like polluted rags:/we have all withered like leaves.../We are the clay and You are the Potter:/we are all the work of Your hands."

SECOND READING: 1 Corinthians 1:3-9

Paul wrote: "[Y]ou are not lacking in any spiritual gift as you wait for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ...God is faithful, and by Him you were called to fellowship with His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord."

GOSPEL READING: Mark 13:33-37

Jesus said, "Be watchful! Be alert! You do not know when the time will come...Watch, therefore" whether at sunset, midnight, cock crow, or sunrise. "Watch!"

"Watch!" The final word of today's Gospel binds together our readings on this First Sunday of Advent. Isaiah watched for the Lord, anticipating that one day God would come down from the heavens and rescue the Chosen People. Paul exhorted the Corinthians to be watchful for the day when the Lord would return. Jesus, Himself compared the Second Coming to the head of the house returning at a time you least expect. May God's Word remind us to wait watchfully for the Lord.
