# **2ND SUNDAY OF LENT - YEAR B**

## **INTRODUCTION TO THE LITURGY OF THE WORD**

#### FIRST READING: Genesis 22:1-2,9a,10-13,15-18

God tested Abraham, asking him to sacrifice his only son Isaac. Seeing Abraham's obedience, God relented. Because of Abraham's faith, God blessed him greatly.

#### **SECOND READING:** Romans 8:31b-34

We have received the ultimate proof of God's love: Christ Jesus, given up to death for the sake of us all. "If God is for us, who can be against us?"

#### **GOSPEL READING:** Mark 9:2-10

Jesus went up a mountain with his disciples and was transfigured before their eyes. A voice from a cloud proclaimed, "This is my beloved So. Listen to him."

Today's readings reveal a God of surprises, a God who acts in ways that his followers do not understand. And yet, they trust and follow, and their lives were forever changed. Abraham witnessed the life-changing power of God. Although advanced in age, he and his wife Sarah gave birth to a son, which the Lord asked him to sacrifice on a mountain. Abraham remained faithful in the gospel, Jesus goes up another mountain with three companions, where God reveals Jesus' identity as His Son, and Jesus' role in salvation history. Like Abraham, Jesus and the apostles, let us travel the road and follow the path to glory.

# Annual Lent Observances

"The annual observances of Lent is the special season for the ascent to the holy mountain of Easter. Through its twofold theme of repentance and baptism, the season of Lent disposes both the catechumens and the faithful to celebrate the Paschal mystery. Catechumens are led to the sacraments of initiation by means of the rite of election, the tinizes, and catechesis. The faithful, listening more intently to the Word of God and devoting themselves to prayer, are prepared through a spirit of repentance to renew their baptismal promises." (Ceremonial of Bishops, 249). LENT runs from Ash Wednesday until the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday which then begins the Sacred Paschal Tridium. Lenten weekdays are not commemorated on Solemnities and Feasts. Ash Wednesday and the days of Holy Week take procedure over all Solemnities and Feasts. Alleluia is not sung or said from the beginning of Lent until the Easter Vigil. During Lent the altar should not be decorated with flowers and musical instruments may be played only to give necessary support to the singing. The presentation of the Creed and the Lord's Prayer normally take place in the week after the first and third scrutinies. The readings for the Lenten Masses have been chosen in relation to the themes of baptismal renewal and penance. The Gospels and readings from the Hebrew Scriptures have been selected for their mutual relationship.


