FEAST OF THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

The Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord commemorates Jesus' ascension into Heaven. Historically, this Holy Solemnity has been celebrated 40 days after Easter Sunday – the Thursday in the sixth week of Easter. Most U.S. dioceses, however, have moved the celebration of the

Ascension to the 7th Sunday of Easter. For this reason, it is now often referred to as "Ascension Sunday." The day of celebration -Thursday or Sunday – seems to vary from diocese to diocese and country to country in 2025. When celebrated on a Thursday, the Ascension of the Lord remains a holy day of obligation. The Church expects Catholics to attend Mass every Sunday already, so when the Ascension is celebrated on a Sunday, attendance is doubly encouraged. We are encouraged to reflect on the Ascension with the words of St. Paul in his letter to the Colossians (Col. 3:1-4): "Today our Lord Jesus Christ ascended into heaven; let our hearts ascend with him. Listen to the words of the Apostle: "If you have risen with Christ, set your hearts on the things that are above where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God; seek the things that are above, not the things that are on earth. For just as he remained with us even after his ascension, so we too are already in heaven with him, even though what is promised us has not yet been fulfilled in our bodies."

DOCTRINE CORNER

NON BIBLICAL EVIDENCE FOR JESUS

Almost every major world religion has a teaching about the identity of Jesus. Jews say that Jesus was a human teacher, Muslims say that He was a prophet, and Hindu and Buddhists say that Jesus was an "enlightened man." They all say basically the same thing: Jesus was a great man but He's not God. If it turned out that Jesus was God, however, then even though these religions have some good teachings, I knew they could not be revelation. How would they if they failed to teach about the incredible moment when God became man in the person of Jesus Christ?
